

Results of the 2011 CQ WW DX 160 Meter Contests

“The day two ‘spotlight’ opening to Europe was fantastic, followed by a nice JA opening. This is what makes you come back for more!”—WD5COV.

This was typical of the quotes from many of the operators in the 2011 CQ WW DX 160 Meter CW and SSB Contests. We expected scores to be down somewhat given the increase in solar activity, but you couldn’t tell it from the results. The band just won’t give up! On CW there were 40 Millionaires (scores over 1 Meg; see the Millionaires box in these results). This is down only 8 from 48 in 2010. However, on SSB, only CN2A was able to break the million-point barrier. It was a challenge on SSB this year for sure, but the troops still came out in good numbers. For 2391 logs were submitted, and 1183 for SSB. Special emphasis was put on log checking this year, more on that later.

Congratulations to Peter, K3ZM, who just keeps cranking out big scores from his Virginia Salt Marsh QTH. Peter managed to take the Combined CW/SSB trophy, showing great dedication to the contest. In some cases, there were higher scores on CW than Peter’s combined score, but with no SSB operation, awarding the trophy to the highest CW scoring station was not in the spirit intended. Another notable case was the fabulous operation from CR2X. The station came in third place worldwide on CW with OH2PM at the helm and third place worldwide on SSB with OH2BH operating. With two different operators, we felt the combined trophy should go to the operator and not the station.

Also making the top ten on both modes was 4O3A, Ranko’s superstation with the man himself at the key on CW, and YU1YV operating on SSB.

There are many trophies available in this contest thanks to the generosity of numerous donors. Some categories have very few entrants, and we encourage you to get on the air and give the contest a try. You never know when you will get some “wood for the wall.” A good example is the tale of YC1COZ, who said, “My Antenna was broken in the day-two morning by strong wind :-).” He made only one QSO, but won the Single Operator Oceania trophy! We need more stations like that to give Topband a try. More countries = more fun for everyone.

CW Results

The CW contest is the heart of the CQ160. It seems to be the preferred mode and brings out the worlds’ best for some heated competition. Blowing away the field was Val, RD3A, operating from EF8M, with a margin over half a million points above CR2X (OH2PM op). The line scores between the two logs were extremely close, but EF8M, being in Africa, got a continental bonus for each QSO. If you want to make more points in any CQWW event, go to zone 33! Zone 9 isn’t a bad place either, as P49V proved with a great 6th place world finish in Single Op. Great job, Carl! In the USA Single Op category, K3ZM and W4AN (Jim, VE7ZO, operating from W8JI) were so close their line scores were almost identical. In the end, the difference was 2 multipliers and K3ZM took the prize this time. Speaking of ZM, the “beacon of Topband,” VY2ZM with Mladen YT6W/VY2NU at the key was second in the world behind EF8M. Again, the line scores were very similar, but operating from North America does not provide enough points to overtake a zone 33 station. Mladen still won a nice trophy for Canada, though.

What would a CQWW event be without DXpeditions? Special mention goes to two operators who not only put some rare coun-

tries on the air, but cracked the Top Ten! Ivo, 9A3A, activated T70A finishing fifth, and Richard, K5NA, made the trek to Iceland to pilot TF4X to eighth place DX. Thanks, guys, for a great job.

In the highly competitive Multi Op category, Harry, RA3AUU, and Alex, RW4WR, from P33W edged out UA2FW and his UA2 contesters for world high. PJ2T was close behind for number 3 with the two-man crew of Geoff, K8ND, and Jim, W8WTS. In the USA, it was a good year for the New Englanders at K1LZ. Krassy and the crew beat out the gang at W2GD by only one multiplier and a handful of 10-point QSOs. KC1XX was also in the hunt, and the competition between the big three is quite spirited year after year.

In the Assisted competition, there were 7 scores over 1 million, making it quite competitive. Top honors this time went to OK1RF operating CS2C, edging out RA4LW from ER4A and SN7Q with a whopping 84 multipliers in third. K3WW once again grabbed top SOA for USA/VE, with VE3RZ and NQ4I right on his heels.

In Low Power, VE3NE put on quite a show with the high world score on both modes! That is not easy from North America, especially on both modes. Great job, Lali! Another great show was by S57DX, who was the Low Power winner in EU on both modes.

In QRP, C4M (5B4AGM) amassed 455 hard-earned QSOs to take the world high score, followed by S50X and OK1FKD. In the USA Pat, N8VW, piloted K8MK’s station to number 1 and 5th worldwide.

SSB Results

Here is a good synopsis of the contest from GM4UBJ: “Once again Topband was bursting at the seams from top to bottom with the best of the best battling to be heard above the noise. Nice to work so

There were 1183 logs submitted for 2011. The most popular category was Single Op Low Power with 457 entries, although the conditions were quite challenging for a low power station.

It doesn't happen often, but the top world Single Op score was made by a USA station this time. Paul, N4PN, operated from Tom, W8JL's station to the tune of 620K, edging out K3ZM and newcomer

KK1KW. Paul's score topped DX winner CT3DL, who used the zone 33 advantage to take top DX honors. Martti, OH2BH, was in second from CR2X, followed by D4C operated by IZ4DPV. Thanks for activating the rare ones, guys.

The highest score by far on SSB was made in the Multi Op category by the gang at CN2A, almost tripling anyone else's score! What you probably didn't guess is who the operators were. It was the UA2 Contest Group again, this time in a warmer climate. The group took

top Multi Op honors for Europe on CW and world on SSB. That is Topband dedication at its finest! UA2FF, RN2FA, and UA2FB were the ops.

The next three Multi Op spots were separated only by 25K, with EI7M, UA2FW, and P33W filling the slots.

In the USA, once again K1LZ took top honors, edging out N2CW (W2GD QTH for CW) and NQ4I. NQ4I had only two operators, but managed to hang in very well. Congratulations to Krassy and his crew at K1LZ, who truly are becoming a dominant force in contesting.

In Single Op Assisted, Braco, E77DX, dominated the field with 721K. The next three places were close, with UU7J (UU4JMG), ER4A (UT7ND), and RW2F RT2F) all over 500K. Congrats to W2MF with the top USA SOA score, followed by N8TR and VE3MMQ.

SP2DNI managed to make 216 QSOs QRP, taking top world honors. K5RX battled the QRM to make 161 QSOs to win that section in the USA. QRP on Topband SSB? It takes a lot of patience.

As previously mentioned, VE3NE had the high world score in Low Power Single Op. KP4KE was virtually tied with Lali, but after log checking the margin was 2000 points. Congrats to both on a fine effort. In the USA W4LJM took the top spot with 93K from Kentucky.
