START POSITION: Standing behind counter facing down range with both feet on plate A and holding box with both hands.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal engage only T1, T2 & T3 from **behind** counter. Then move downrange and engage remaining targets.

(Beware of 180 rule.)


SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points

TARGETS: 9 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. –10, Miss. -10

SETUP NOTES: Set T1-T3 18-20 feet down range from counter. Set NS immediately beyond counter and centered on counter.

T4 & T7 are hidden behind barricades. T6, T8 & T9 are hidden behind cable reels and barrel. Use 2x4 on either side of cable reel to prevent rolling. (Cut to length, drill hole for spike and spike down.)

Set T5 high and check for shoot through.

Use what is already in big bay: 1 table (turn sideways), 2 cable drums, 2 barricades, 1 barrel

Required: 12 target bases and sticks

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
