START POSITION: Seated at the bench with gavel in strong hand. Loaded pistol lying on mat in front center of bench. Pistol may not be propped up in any way.

STAGE PROCEDURE


On the command "Are you ready?" the judge begins banging the gavel on block and continues to the beeb. Targets T1, T2, PP1, USP1 must be engaged from between the two NS in front of the bench only. Targets T3, T4, T5, T6, USP2, USP3 may be engaged any where. Targets T7, T8, P1 P2 must be engaged from the "doorway" only. All targets must be engaged without crossing any fault line.

SCORING

SETUP NOTES: Set T1-T8 5 feet high. USP1 is to be hidden by PP1. Use wall to hide T4, T5. Use barrels to hide USP2, USP3 so that only one may be seen at a time. Set NS in doorway so that only one pair of targets may be seen at a time.

Props Required: 11 bases, 22 long 1x2, 1 wall, 2 barricades or 1 doorway, 2 barrels, 1 PP, 3 USP, 2 8" plates, 1 table, 1 chair, fasten a 4 inch piece of 2x4 to table in front of chair. Place mat or rug centered on far edge of table.
