START POSITION: Standing in box facing up range in surrender position, hands above shoulders. Either left or right box may be used.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Turn, draw and engage the targets.


T6 is a disappearing target actuated by PP1. PP1 must be knocked down before engaging T6.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 24 rounds, 120 points TARGETS: 11 IPSC, 1 PP, 1 8-inch dia. plate SCORED HITS: Best per 2 IPSC, KD = 1A START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10 No-shoot hit. -10

SETUP NOTES: Set T1 & T11 3 feet high, T2 & T10 4 feet high, all other targets 5 feet high.

Setup should provide 3 groups of 8 shots. Use 3 barricades as shown in center so that movement is required to engage T5-T7 & steel. Put 4th barricade behind center of left wall to limit shooting around corner. Do same for right wall.

Check for shoot throughs.

PROPS REQUIRED: 2 wall sections, 5 barricades, 2 boxes, 10 target bases, 1 8-inch plate w/stand, 1 PP w/actuator, 1 turning target, 12 long 1x2, 8 short 1x2

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
